



Wedding flowers

Firstly, huge congratulations on your engagement! By now, you should have set the date and booked the venue and now it's time to think about the flowers..(the best bit!)

Be sure to enquire about your wedding date and we'll arrange a time for you to pop along for a cuppa and a chat about all things flowery in our new, cosy studio. I suggest you bring with you any ideas you've seen, a picture of your wedding attire, colour swatches etc- anything you have that will help me get a sense for how you'd love your wedding day to look and feel.

We'll then discuss all your requirements, from bouquets to buttonholes, ceremony flowers to reception arrangements. Ideally, it's best to have a budget for your flowers in mind so that our meeting can be concise and the ideas we discuss are suitable for your budget.

After our meeting we will prepare a detailed quotation for your requirements and email the document to you within 7 working days.

Quotations are valid for 30 days, if you would love to book us as your wedding florist please let us know as soon as possible so we can reserve your wedding date. To fully secure your date in the

diary, we require a signed copy of our Terms & Conditions (printed or digital) and a non-refundable booking fee of £100.

Once we've received these things, we will confirm your booking and continue to be available via email for any questions and adjustments to your flower plans.

If you require a site visit, an additional fee is payable to cover our time & travel costs.

On your wedding day...

Your bridal flowers will be delivered to you in the morning at an agreed time prior to your big day. Bridal bouquets will be delivered in water and their stems will need dabbing dry 20 minutes before you leave. (Perhaps a task for the maid of honour)

Your ceremony and venue flowers will be set up on the morning or the day before, depending on the logistics. All hire items will be collected the next day unless otherwise agreed.

To get the best out of your bridal and bridesmaid bouquets, make sure there are some vases filled with water waiting for you at your reception. It's a great way to ensure their longevity and to have extra floral decoration around the venue.
